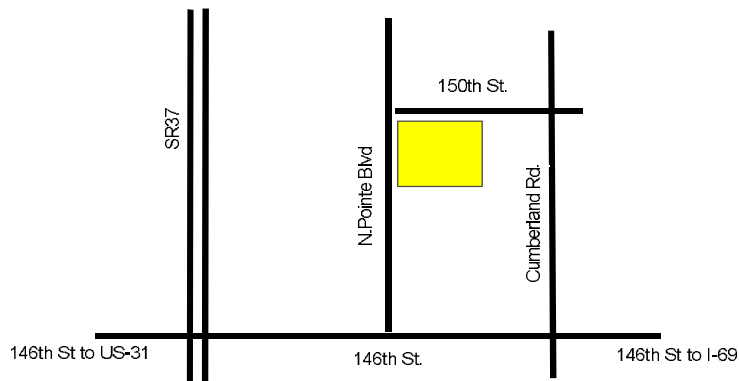
DRIVING DIRECTIONS:
